

2016 School Results Summary

The Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 results for 2016 cannot be compared to results from previous years because both the curriculum and the way in which pupils are assessed have changed significantly this year. Please note that the charts below are based on preliminary data from Wiltshire. Final validated results will not be published nationally by the DFE until February 2017.

We are very pleased with our attainment results. Our end of Key Stage attainment scores are all above, or in line with, the national and Wiltshire average, with the exception of maths in Key Stage 1. In particular, we are delighted with the children's performance in reading and in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) at the end of Key Stage 2 and with the percentage of our pupils who passed the Year 1 phonics screening test. Our Foundation Stage Profile scores are also very pleasing. Once again, these good outcomes are the result of the hard work and dedication of all of the staff who support the children's education so well.
