

In English this term, we are focusing on using a variety of sentence types (simple, compound and complex) and ensuring that these are punctuated correctly. We are beginning to look at using more advanced punctuation such as semi-colons, colon and dashes to separate two main clauses. To apply this in our writing, we are learning about the key features of recounts, diaries and newspaper reports and then using this knowledge to write our own.

In Maths, we are consolidating our understanding of place value - both in whole numbers and decimal numbers. We are also going to focus on the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and applying these in the context of word problems.

Our Topic this term is 'The Horrible History of London'. We are looking at The Great Fire of London, The Plague and The Blitz as well as other aspects of London's history.

Science this term is all about thinking scientifically. We will be raising questions, learning about dependent and independent variables, carrying out investigations, writing methods and interpreting our results.

In Art, we are learning about the life and works of Claude Monet. We have just begun to create our own piece of art in the style of Monet.

In PE, we are focusing on football and gymnastics.

In Music, we are listening to, learning about and appraising the well-known Bon Jovi song, 'Livin' on A Prayer!'

In RE, we are learning about 'moral codes' and thinking about how this may influence our behaviour. We will then link this learning with the religion of Christianity and will be comparing and contrasting this with our own views.
